FULLY LIVING settled off the early pace into the turn, moved four wide in mid-turn, gained the lead entering the lane and widened the final eight while being kept to the task. TRIPLEDODGAREYA chased the pace from the three path through the turn, moved four wide into the lane when gaining momentum, could not gain on the winner while finishing clear for the place spot. TRAIL WALKER set behind three rival duel through the turn, moved three wide into the lane when chasing the leaders then could not gain on the top two while best of the rest. SPLURGESS pressed the pace three wide into the turn, moved to the lead in mid-turn then was empty in the drive. DON'T TELL VEDA was bumped at the start, raced in the two path through the turn, floated to the five path for the drive and was never a serious factor. BARGAIN BLITZ vied for the lead along the inside into the turn then faded. OUI OUI CHERI was in the three path through the turn, moved to the six path for the drive and was never a contender. POINT TO THE WILD vied for the lead two wide into mid-turn then retreated thereafter.
