### Footnotes

EL SOMBRE was in the two path into the turn, continued in the two or three path into the lane, caught the leaders near the sixteenth pole and edged up late. RAFF was unhurried early while off the inside, moved four or five wide into the lane, gained momentum while floating to the six or seven path and was closing in. NOTORIETY chased the pace along the inside, bid into the lane, gained a short lead inside the eighth pole and was outfinished by the top two. ZELLERS was four wide through the first turn, moved to the set the pace into the turn, continued on the front entering the lane then gave way near the sixteenth pole. MARCHING ORDERS raced near the rail through the turn, came into the lane in good position then hung. THE DUCK OF REED was along the inside into the lane and never threatened. MR. LATONIA vided for the lead early then chased the pace into the lane then faded. ONCEINMYLIFETIME was four wide through the turn and into the lane an was empty. A ROD was outrun while near the inside. HALLELUJAH was three wide into the turn then dropped out near the three-eighths pole.
