**Footnotes**

SAUCEY ROMANCE settled early, moved four wide through the turn to gain the lead, continued with a clear advantage into the lane and widened through the final eighth. SPICE OF LIFE was unhurried early while off the inside, bid from the five path into the lane and could not threaten the winner while finishing second best. LINDA'S MOONSHINE pressed the pace two wide through the turn, had nothing else to give in the lane and was all out to hold the minor share. COZY FOR NOW came into the lane from the four path and was empty late. MISS BOBBIE was in the two or three path through the turn and moved up while not a threat. MAID TO A TEE was three wide through the turn when pressing the pace and was finished entering the lane. PAVARENDA was done early while in the three or four path through the turn. DERBY STREET DOLL set the early pace into the turn then steadily faded along the inside. ELLENS TAP was finished early from along the inside. LADY AT ARMS trailed throughout from the two or three path.
