**Footnotes**

SAVANNAH HARBOR set the pace while appearing to be traveling easily down the backstretch, maintained a clear advantage entering the top of the stretch, and held off challengers while being kept to task. GOLDEN N BEAUTIFUL was between horses in the second flight early, moved up along the rail approaching the turn, angled out three wide between horses at the top of the lane, made a run at the leader but was no match. DIXIE DREAMIN tracked the leader along the inside, lacked the needed closing response. STRAWBERRY QUAKE chased the leaders while three wide down the backstretch, drifted out to the four path on the turn, finished evenly. GALAXY JET was given right-handed urging from the from the gate and lacked a response. JAY'S VALENTINE raced between horses in the first flight early, dropped back and was empty thereafter.
