EXPRESS MODEL pressed the pace two wide into the turn, settled back to chase the pacesetter into the lane, gained momentum after straightening then drove past and cleared while being kept to the task. THE LAST P was five wide into the turn, continued three wide through the turn and into the lane then moved up for the place spot while not a threat to the winner. TRICIA'S TRAMA was off a step slow start, raced in the three or four path through the turn and into the lane and was up for the minor share. JIMNPAULS LAST TOY set the pace under pressure into the turn, shook clear into the lane then gave way when challenged near the eighth pole. PLATINUM JUSTICE was never a factor while in the two or three path through the turn. CARMALLEY CAT was in the two path through the turn and never factored. FAITH AND A PRAYER chased the pace from the two or three path into the lane then tired in the drive. DIABLO MABEE was done early while in the four path into the lane. WEEKEND MEMORIES trailed throughout while in the two or three path through the turn.
