Footnotes

I LIKE BEER chased the pace from the three path through the turn, continued in mid-track for the drive, inched up on the top two approaching the sixteenth pole and drove past late. KEE KEE LEE chased the pace into the turn, bid in mid-turn, continued on near even terms with an eight to go, was inching up on leader when passed by the winner late. ERIN'S CHARGE set the pace from the inside into the lane, was collared by the runner-up in late turn then yielded to that one late. HOW'S THE WEATHER was along the inside into the lane and moved up while not a threat. WIN CASTLE was in the three or four path into the lane, continued in mid-track for the drive and lacked a closing response. TAKE DAT PUDDY TAT was in the five path through the turn and lacked a bid. MAJIC LITE chased the pace along the inside through the turn and faded. JACKIM was outrun from the inside. CENTURY SHAKE UP hopped at the start then raced far back throughout.
