Footnotes

JENRY set the pace along the inside through the turn while on a clear lead, widened into the lane and held on to a diminishing advantage. TACHI was along the inside through the turn, gained momentum through the latter stages of the turn, shifted to the three path near the eighth pole and finished with good energy. CATCH THIS WARRIOR was in the two path through the turn and into the lane and moved up for the minor share while not a threat to the winner. DYNAMITE STICK chased the pace from the two path through the turn then weakened in the drive. THURMAN was in the two path through the turn and moved up. WHAT'S A YAT chased the pace from the three path through the turn and tired in the lane. HARD LIMITS was done early while racing in the four path through the turn. TAZDUE chased the pace from the four path through the turn and was finished entering the lane. TOTAL JUSTICE the right panel of the starting gate was slow to open due to a pad becoming lodged behind the hinge resulting in the horse pushing the gate open upon release then raced in the back and never contended.
