### Footnotes

GRANDPA GRUMPY set the pace while near the inside, widened into the lane and held while being kept to intermittent urging. WALLSTREET FLASH was bumped at the start, raced in the three or four path through the turn and into the lane and moved up to be far clear for the place spot while not a threat to the winner. CHARLIE ST GOLD unhurried early, raced in the three or four path through the turn, fanned into mid-track for the drive and moved up to just get up for the minor share. THATS MYBUDDY BOY was in the the two path through the turn, moved to the three path into the lane and lacked a closing bid. BETTER WATCH ME chased the pace along the inside into the lane then faded through the lane. ROAN RENEGADE was never a factor while saving ground into the lane. IMMINENT IMPACT was bumped twice at the start, raced near the rail through the turn and never contended. MY SON DARREN was done early while in the two or three path through the turn. ORIENT FORTY chased the pace from the three path through the turn then faded down the lane. CAPTAIN BEEP BEEP dropped back along the rail entering the far turn.
