Footnotes

ALLEY BAR was forced five wide on the first turn before settling off the pace for the run down the backstretch, moved up while four wide entering the far turn, took command at the top of the stretch and just lasted. THANK YOU KISSES unhurried early, had to steady very slightly entering the first turn four wide, content to rate toward the rear of the field down the backstretch, commenced a four wide rally at the three eighths pole and just missed. JOINT TENANT stalked the pace two wide, was empty in the lane. H K JUNIOR was carried three to four wide around the first turn, stalked the leaders, no rally. SPEED RAIL was able to secure a rail trip while racing off the pace, shifted out two wide at the top of the lane, had no late response. SUNDAY PURSUIT had to steady slightly entering the first turn, raced three wide throughout, weakened. EQUIANO was forced to steady slightly entering the first turn, showed little. FLATTER CREEK stumbled at the start, was rushed to the lead, set the pace along the rail, was through at the five sixteenths.
