NOT AGAIN NANCYE vied for the lead from the inside into the turn, was steadied off the pace through the turn, bid into the lane, hooked the leader near the eighth pole then inched to the front very late. QUALITY MOMENT vied for the lead along the inside into the turn, cleared before reaching mid-turn, was collared near the eighth pole and lost the duel while digging in gamely. MIDNIGHT SWEETIE was in the four path into the lane, moved closer to the top two with a furlong to go then could not gain further while clear for the show spot. BRIEF REIGN chased the pace from the three path through the turn and lacked a closing response. CARLOW DAISY was never a factor while along the inside. MENTALLY UNSTABLE was off a step slow, raced in the two or three path and never menaced. TORQING ON chased the pace from the three path through the turn then faded through the lane.
