DANCE PROUDLY set the pace through the turn while in the three path, shook free entering the lane and widened while being kept to the task to the end. KEE KEE LEE chased the pace from the three path through the turn, bid into the lane from the four path, could not gain on the winner while holding on to the place spot late. HUNTIN A WIN tracked the pace along the inside through the turn, was asked for more inside the eighth pole and was inching up for the place spot and missed. TAKE DAT PUDDY TAT was in the for path through the turn and into the lane and lacked the needed response. SUGAR'S PRETTY BOY was in the three path into the lane and was never a serious threat. KINGSTON CAT was unhurried early while near the inside, angled into the six path entering the lane and never factored. LAKE ROYAL well back into the lane while in the four or five path and drifted to the inside and never was a menace. TOMMIE TWO TOES was in the four path through the turn when in contention then tired in the lane. WALLSTREET JOSH trailed through the turn, fanned into the lane from the seven path, ducked out sharply when hit right-handed and rider lost her irons and never menaced thereafter. FAST MOE was done early while along the inside. PROPER REWARD was finished early while racing near the inside. JACKIM showed little while in the two or three path through the turn.
