Footnotes

WORK ALL WEEK vied for the lead two wide into the turn, cleared approaching the quarter pole then slowly widened through the lane. TRIUMPH AND SONG stumbled at the start, raced in the two path through the turn, bid three wide into the lane then was all out to gain the place spot while not a threat to the winner. BULL DOZER was along the rail through the turn, came off the inside while passing tired one, moved back to the inside near the eighth pole then needed more late. BISCOTTO chased the pace from the two or three path through the turn and into the lane, was well placed with a furlong to go then weakened. CLOSERWALK vied for the lead along the inside through the turn and into the lane then tired. ESCORT was in the three path through the turn and was done after straightening in the lane.
