Footnotes

LUREGO brushed inside rival just slightly at the start, assumed a tracking position in the second flight while racing on the rail, shifted out two wide entering the far turn, waited momentarily while behind horses at the top of the lane, shifted out a further path for clear running room, was given a couple taps with the whip, edged clear while under a vigorous hand ride the final sixteenth. DELTA GOLF ALPHA was brushed slightly at the start and then taken back early, swept four wide on the far turn, couldn't get to winner while second best. WEST MALIBU cleared all but the top two early and angled to rail prior to the first turn, saved ground throughout, got through on the rail at the eighth pole, was no match for top two but held for show honors. DALTON TO GREEN was unhurried early while racing mid-pack, advanced while three wide entering the far turn, just missed show while finishing evenly. STEPONIT broke out a bit, chased the pacesetter while racing in the three path on the first turn, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, weakened in the lane. BEAT THE STORM was bumped slightly at the start and eager to make the pace while racing well off the rail throughout, faced first one then multiple challengers at the top of the lane and gave way. COABEY raced two wide while mid-pack, through early. HIDDEKEL was four wide on the first turn, trailed throughout.
