PURRRPURRR chased the pacesetter from the two path through the turn, gained momentum into the lane, quickly moved past the tiring pace and widened. BEST MEMORIES was crowded at the start, raced well back through the turn from the three path then finished with good energy to gain the place spot. TRICIA'S TRAMA was in the three path through the turn when never far back, swung into mid-track for the drive and lacked a closing response while holding the minor share. LA TUSA set a fast pace into the lane then tired along the rail and lost the place and show spot late. CARMALLEY CAT broke in and was bumped by outside rival at the start, raced at the back into the lane when swinging out five wide and gained belatedly. MAMA LOCK gained momentum from the four path into the lane, looked to be a contender with three-sixteenths to run then hung. WEEKEND MEMORIES broke in at the start, raced in the two path through the turn and was never a contender. SEATTLE MOUNTAIN was bumped at the start, ridden into contention into the turn then tired. I'LL BACK YOU UP stumbled at the start, chased the pace along the inside then faded. LIL DAGGETT steadily faded while in the two path.
