### Footnotes

ALKE POKER broke sharply but was content to rate just off the flank of the pacesetter inside, drew abreast of that one on the far turn, obtained a clear lead by the eighth pole and held well under first right-handed then left-handed urging. FATHER JOHN couldn't quite keep up early, chased the pace among the second flight, inched closer going four wide midway on the turn, raced evenly while second best. LIVING BREAD was allowed to settle in the second flight racing inside a rival, raced in the three path on the turn, up for show honors. RAPID WARRIOR rushed to set a pressured pace, dueled with the eventual winner on the turn, yielded in the lane. OAK RICH unhurried early, raced in the there to four path entering the turn, swinging out to the six path by time he entered the lane, passed tired rivals. T. L. SENSATION chased inside, never threatened. SIAGON TRAFFIC COP raced in the three path, had nothing late. VERY CLEAR received an inside trip, was always outrun.
