MISTER POLLARD stalked the pace in behind the dueling leaders while saving ground, was angled out on the turn and rallied into the stretch, drew clear and was all out to hold sway late. PAUL REIFF dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, led to mid stretch, weakened and could not go with the winner but was second best. MATTER OF FACT was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too little too late. JENRY broke in the air, was unhurried early, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. RHYTHM MABEE was unhurried early while saving ground, was taken up while in tight in the stretch, had no rally. SECONDHAND JUSTICE dueled for the lead and pressed the pace from the outside, faltered in the stretch and faded. JUST A MORGAN flashed brief speed before stopping.
