OUR FRIEND HARRY was allowed to settle early, steadily advanced four wide entering the turn, struck the lead at the eighth pole and edged clear while being kept to task. BLUEGALE was hustled from the start to obtain position tracking the leaders along the inside, split horses at the sixteenth pole to gain place. LUNGS attended the pace early from a wide position, weakened in the lane. MR. WATANABE TOO broke alertly to dictate the pace, gave way. COMMANDEER was close early, went three wide on the turn, had no late rally. DUNRAVEN PASS saved ground throughout, never threatened. TENACIOUS TIGER was no factor. MARCHING ORDERS trailed throughout.
