HIDDEN HEAT attended the pace two to three wide while rationing speed nicely, drew alongside sparring partner on the turn, inched away from that one in the lane and just lasted in holding off the late charge of BREAD LINE, who was content to sit off the pace early, shifted out three to four wide in the latter portion of the turn and into the lane to commence a slow, steady gain that just missed. JUMPING JUSTICE shifted out on the turn to enter the lane four to five wide, raced evenly throughout and improved position. MI ERMANNA TINA set a pressured pace inside, weakened in the lane, was just outfinished for the show honors. GOLD 'N WHITE raced in the second flight between runners early, never threatened. MARIANNE CAN was in the five path throughout, never factored. DAZZLEWITHDIAMONDS tracked inside while showing brief speed, gave way.
