### Footnotes

PICO SUAVE was well placed in mid pack while four wide, rallied into the stretch and wore down the leader and drew clear late while drifting out. SCATTERFIELD duled for the lead and pressed the pace from the outside, could not go with the winner but was second best. LAWYER DAGGETT stalked the pace from between horses early, ran evenly with no rally. HESRAISINCAIN was five wide and lost ground, had no rally. DEMI FLAME was void of early speed, improved position but was no factor. MAN OF MIRACLES was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. OUR ROCK STAR duled for the lead and set the pace from between horses, was through after a half mile, faltered and faded. H K JUNIOR failed to menace. STRAWBERRY AMOUR was no threat. BUSTER ROSE flashed brief speed, was through after a half mile and stopped.
