MISTER POLLARD dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, drew off in upper stretch, was all out to last late late while drifting out. BISQUE was well placed in mid pack, was caught in behind horses on the turn, rallied into the stretch but found his best stride late and was gaining but too late. TACHI was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. FEARLESS JUSTICE prompted the pace while saving ground, faltered in the stretch and faded. PAUL REIFF was unhurried early, rallied on the turn and loomed a threat in upper stretch, failed to sustain the bid but had a nice middle move. AFT was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. THURMAN dueled for the lead and set the pace, was through after a half mile and dropped back. CHICKS DIG IT flashed brief speed, bore out entering the turn and was taken up, gave way and dropped back. SALTY RIM failed to menace and was outrun.
