ROLL N SHINE was allowed to settle in the early going, advanced five wide on the turn, collared the leaders in mid-stretch and edged clear in the final furlong while being kept to task. MIGHTY FREE stalked in the early going, moved to contention three to four wide on the turn, engaged in a long drive ying for the lead, was no match for the winner. ZACAMAC was hustled along after the break to obtain position along the rail tracking the leaders, was checked behind horses at the quarter pole, angled out at the eighth pole, was gaining on the second place finisher late. HUNTING FOR DIABLO settled off the pace, steadily advanced, shifted out in upper stretch, finished evenly while improving position. BETTER WATCH ME pressed two wide, angled in to the rail in upper stretch, weakened inside the final furlong. TWO STASH raced three wide on the turn, improved position, finished evenly. RICHARD HART chased three wide in the early going, drifted out to the five path at the top of the lane, dropped back. MY MAN JACK raced in the six path into the lane, had no rally. SEARCH THE LOU passed tired rivals. GETTHEWHEELBARROW angled to the rail shortly after the start, was through early. JACOBS SHADOW was hard used to set the pace, gave way. THURBEN raced wide, outrun.
