SPOOF was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch and circled the field, was all out to get up in the final strides. HOT EMBER stalked the pace with good early speed, rallied into the stretch and led late, was outfinished to the wire. CAPITOL E dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, faltered in the stretch and faded. EM ROCZ was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. SHE'SABIT MOODY stalked the pace while saving ground, was no threat. SEPARATION bobbed and bore in at the start, was no threat. TAX BREAKER dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered in the stretch and faded, was no factor. STERLINA was shuffled back at the start, was no threat.
