STAKES Michael G. Schaefer Memorial S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND OLDER. No nomination fee. \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start with \$100,000 added. Supplementary nominations may be made by the usual time of closing of entries for a fee \$750 which includes entry and starting fees. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last the remainder of the purse will be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 121 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 once or \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2013, allowed 3 lbs; of \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2013, 5 lbs; of \$21,000 at any distance in 2013, 7 lbs. Maiden, claiming, starter and state bred races will not be considered when estimating allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Should more than twelve horses pass the entry box preference will be given to (1) Graded stake winners in 2012 - 2013, (2) High Weights (scale of weights and sex allowances considered), (3) Highest lifetime earnings.

Footnotes

BERNIE THE MAESTRO was in a bit tight and taken back shortly after the start, settled off the pace racing in the clear, steadily advanced into the turn, moved four wide around the far turn but still had much to do, engaged in a long drive to get up late. TAPTOWNE tracked the pace along the inside, shifted out to bid two wide on the turn, opened a clear lead in upper stretch but yielded late. NECK 'N NECK was unhurried early and content to bring up the rear, shifted five or six wide on the far turn, closed best of all and very much willingly but ran out of real estate. JOY BOY set the pace racing just off the rail, yielded in the lane. IT HAPPENED AGAIN was in a bit tight on the first turn, went four wide on the far turn, never appeared tremendously comfortable in the off going and finished up evenly. DECISIVE MOMENT stalked the pacesetter two wide, weakened after half. SABERCAT was caught four wide on the first turn in an attempt to curry a good stalking position, angled inside on the backstretch, cut the corner but had no late rally. GOOD LORD chased the pace off the rail, weakened. RAIL TRIP raced moderately close early, steadily retreated while appearing to labor over the surface.
