Footnotes

DAVIS HARBOR was close early racing inside the pacesetter and off the rail before taking back at the seven sixteenths pole and angling outside that rival, was then asked to go and drew alongside rivals, struck the lead at the top of the lane, appeared to wait on horses in deep stretch but managed to last while being given continuous right-handed urging throughout. CROSSED HEARTS relaxed off the early pace, steadily advanced in the three path till upper stretch at which point she angled in to the rail, continued to gain on the leader but just missed while well clear of the others to be second best. TORQING ON dictated the pace racing well off the rail, weakened in the lane. GUMBO LIMBO received an inside trip and passed tired rivals. STARTTHEBALLROLLIN raced four to five wide and offered no late bid. GIVINITMYALL chased the early leaders, was done after half. BLUEJOY was pinched back and bobbed shortly after the start, angled to the rail and never threatened. JOHNS LADY was no factor. CIRCUS ATTITUDE made a middle move to challenge for the lead along the rail before giving way.
