Footnotes

CHUCKIE was content to bring up the rear in the early going, raced three to four wide throughout from an unhurried vantage point, inched closer to the vanguard on the far turn, waited until upper stretch to commence his bid at which point he split horses and spurred to the lead, held that lead under steady handling. TAKE DAT PUDDY TAT raced four to five wide throughout, bid on the far turn and into the lane, was game for place. WILD SIP settled just off the pace for the opening quarter, advanced quickly in a middle-move down the backstretch to vie for the lead four wide, yielded in the final furlong. HOW'S THE WEATHER stalked the pace duel outside a rival in the second flight, bid midway on the turn, drifted out a bit in upper stretch and weakened in the lane. CALL ME FERDIE tracked from the inside in the second flight, angled out several paths in mid-stretch but had no late bid. WALLSTREET FLASH dueled inside, weakened. DAREWIN RICH failed to menace. WALLSTREET JOSH was a bit sluggish at the start then rushed to the lead, dueled outside a rival, gave way.
