SUNSHINEANDSILENCE stalked the pace while four wide, rallied on the turn and dueled through the stretch, began to draw clear late under constant urging. GALLOPING DOMINO dueled for the lead from between horses, went to the lead on the turn, weakened late but held the place. FIB was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain. ON THE SAME PAGE was well placed while three wide, ran evenly with no rally. TRIPLEDODGAREYA was void of early speed, had a late rally mid track and was gaining. DR MEGANN was well placed early, rallied on the turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. LA GRENOUILLE failed to menace. NOTORIOUSLY NOBLE dueled for the lead and set the pace, broke down on the turn and was pulled up, was vanned off.
