**Footnotes**

BLUEGALE stalked the leaders three wide, commenced a move at the top of the lane and engaged in a long drive, got up late to prevail. NASTY BOY set the pace racing off the rail, widened into and on the turn, appeared to shorten stride late, yielded inside the final sixteenth but gamely held on for place. TENACIOUS TIGER stalked the leader, angled inside that one at the top of the lane, made a strong bid up the rail in upper stretch and appeared poised to sneak through but flattened out in the final sixteenth. BOLD OCCURANCE settled off the pace in the early going, raced inside on or just off the rail throughout, gaining through the lane. KENDALL M. D. was content to trail through the early going and was still last at the top of the lane, had shifted to the five path heading into the lane, gained through the stretch run. PULP chased the leaders, weakened, was vanned off. DUNRAVEN PASS made a mild middle move on the turn three wide before weakening. HIGH STAKES was close early racing four wide, faded. HARRY CANARY showed little while racing roughly four wide throughout. JONES N CASH showed brief speed along the inside, gave way at about the three eighths pole.
