ALANDTOM was unhurried into stride, worked his way forward between rivals through the turn, split horses entering the stretch, shook clear and held safely. SORGHO was allowed to settle, finished with a late rally and clearly proved second best. CARPENTER JACK stalked the pace, moved up through the turn to make his bid but lacked the needed late response. NOBLE CYRUS was unhurried early, rallied between horses and improved position through the lane. LE CHEVALIER opened clear to set the pace, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. SHERTZER made a middle move to offer a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. JOHN MAPLES failed to threaten. OUR NOBLE HEART was forwardly placed along the inside, but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out. BOLD NORTH was close up three wide for six furlongs and dropped out. BOLD ADVENTURE was through after a half. PROMISED DAY was through early.
