DEPECHE CHAT stalked the pace, took over four wide entering the stretch, opened clear, drifted about through the drive but increased the advantage. UNCLE BRENT settled in hand, advanced between horses, loomed a danger entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. SAN ANTONE was unhurried into stride, swung to the outside entering the stretch and was making up ground. STAY PUT was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. SERUNI was allowed to settle in mid pack and lacked a response when called upon. LIL BIT O'FUN failed to respond. RATATAT made a middle move, assumed command on the turn, but gave way readily once headed entering the stretch. TAINO was away alertly, set the early pace, was collared on the turn, contested the issue for a half and stopped.
