FORT LARNED stalked the pace in hand, ranged up three wide to make a bold bid, forged command inside the furlong marker and edged clear. GUNMAN settled saving ground, closed the gap through the turn, angled out entering the stretch but was unable to reach the winner. NDONGO was allowed to settle, came five wide and was making up ground. NIGHT PARTY vied for the lead three wide to the final furlong and flattened. HEIDEN was away alertly, disputed the pace along the inside to the final furlong and gave way. SUPREME RULER was hustled along four wide to the stretch and retreated. SILVERDADDYOFMINE raced wide throughout and was never a factor. THE OFFICIAL ORDER OF FINISH WAS CORRECTED AFTER THE RACE WAS DECLARED OFFICIAL WHEN IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT NIGHT PARTY ACTUALLY FINISHED FOURTH, NOT FIFTH. BOTH NIGHT PARTY AND HEIDEN WERE CREDITED WITH FOURTH PLACE EARNINGS. THE NEW OFFICIAL PLACEMENTS DID NOT AFFECT THE THE MUTUEL PAYOFF FOR THE SUPERFECTA WAGER.
