STRIKE THE NOTE opened clear to set the pace, was collared before going a half, shook off REDWOOD KITTEN entering the stretch, shook loose and held safely. GIACOSLEW settled in hand, made a late rally between horses and finished willingly to earn the place. REDWOOD KITTEN moved up to engage the leader, disputed the pace to the stretch, but weakened during the drive and settled for the show. COUNTING DAYS stalked the pace in hand, moved up to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. SLEWPY'S IMAGE was unhurried into stride, finished with a late rally and improved position. SQUALL KING was forwardly place through the turn and tired. R. J. NEAR GOLD contended to the final furlong and retreated. ENGLISH POUND failed to respond. ANIMAL HOUR showed little. COMMENCING was never a factor. MI STO DIVERTENDO was hung wide and was never involved. MOONLIGHT RAID was through early.
