TERUBCHEH sped clear to dictate terms and led throughout. OXNARD stalked the pace in hand, moved up four wide to make his bid, kept on well but was unable to reach the winner. PROSPECT ROAD was allowed to settle, split rivals to make a late rally and was along for the show. HEART O'GOLD contended three wide to the stretch, but weakened during the drive and finished evenly. CANE SWAGGER attended the pace along the inside, got through but lacked the needed late response. STORMIN HEDGES was allowed to settle, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. COWCUTTA failed to respond. WEE ALEX was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and retreated. BALTERSAN showed little. THEODORE'S CASH was slow into stride and never a factor. BOONDOCK ROMEO was always outrun.
