CONSOLE sprinted clear to dictate terms off of the inside, widened at will leaving the turn and into the stretch, was in hand for the final furlong and held safely. GEOTHERMAL was allowed to settle, advanced between horses, angled out entering the stretch and was making up ground. JESSE STONE was forwardly placed, came three wide but lacked the needed late response. STARTER was slow into stride, split horses to make a late rally but failed to seriously threaten. PISGAH STATION was slow early, finished with a belated gain and improved position. SMILE DADDY was away alertly to attend the pace, but came up empty leaving the turn and retreated. SUMAN KHAR contended three wide for a half and dropped out. JO BOB failed to respond. E. M. MAXIMUS was hustled along five wide, but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out. BARNYARD FIDDLER was through early.
