FANTASTIQUE opened clear to set the pace off of the inside, drifted out five wide leaving the turn, widened the advantage through the upper stretch and held safely through the drive. HUNT FOR COLLEEN was close up three wide, failed to menace the winner but stayed on fairly well to earn the place. GUIDING FORCE attended the pace along the inside, got through to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. LITTLE JEANNIE was hustled along three wide while never far back, but weakened in the final furlong and faded. SING THE MELODY was allowed to settle, made a belated gain between rivals but failed to threaten. PHILOSOPHER QUEEN was unhurried into stride, swung five wide but lacked a response when called upon. BAHIA BEACH was forwardly placed toward the inside but came up empty before going a half and dropped out.
