SHE'S COAL FIRED sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace inside, repulsed several bids entering the stretch and drew off under steady handling. BAD BOB closest to the pace off the inside, challenged the winner late on the turn, was no match in the stretch but held on for the place. APPROVETHISMESSAGE within striking distance off the inside, improved his position while no threat. MARTY THE MONSTER outrun along the inside, showed some late interest. KENRADO outrun three wide, was no threat. DON SUAVE steadied early, recovered, made a good four wide move on the turn to challenge approaching the stretch but gave way in the drive. OROMOCTO hesitated at the start, made a good three wide move on the turn, challenged approaching the stretch but faded.
