### Footnotes

DIPSY DREW stalked the pace four wide, ranged up to join the leaders leaving the turn, shook clear and maintained a safe advantage. THUNDER was allowed to settle, tipped out six wide entering the stretch, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. CLAUDE MONET was allowed to settle, launched his bid between horses, loomed a danger but wasn't quite good enough. JAZIL BELL settled in hand, moved up to engage the leaders leaving the turn, but weakened during the drive and gave way. CAIRO SIX contended toward the inside, shifted out leaving the turn but lacked a response when called upon. XINGU was allowed to settle, came six wide and finished with some late run. BANG BANG BERTI settled saving ground, but failed to respond. GREY BY YOU contested pace along the inside through the turn and dropped out. ANILLO was away alertly to set the pace, was collared before going a half, disputed the issue to the stretch and faltered. OTTER COVE lagged far back, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. CARNI showed little.
