Footnotes

GATTINO was allowed to settle, swung wide entering the stretch, wore down the leaders inside the furlong marker and edged clear. TWENTYONEANDCHANGE vied for the lead off of the inside, edged clear nearing the quarter pole, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. BACK DOWNTHE AISLE stalked the pace, bid between horses, kept on willingly but wasn't quite good enough. SADDLE IRENA attended the pace along the

inside, waited in traffic leaving the turn, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. MARTINI STREET was away alertly, was put in tight and steadied down the hill, settled in hand toward the inside, shifted out entering the stretch, split horses and was making up ground. BYE LOVE YOU was shuffled back early losing position, swung ten wide leaving the turn, finished well but was left with too much to do. RED BANKS REALITY stalked the pace, drew even four wide, drifted in under right handed urging, bumped GALATIA inside the quarter pole and flattened during the drive. GOLDENWILDCHILD was awkward into stride down the hill, was allowed to settle, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. WILLUBMYSUGARDADDY contended off of the inside, steadied near the three-eighths pole, came again between horses, but was bumped nearing the furlong marker and went evenly thereafter. GALATIA settled between horses, moved up to make a mild bid, was bumped nearing the furlong marker and faltered in the drive. BULLISH BABE contested the pace three wide, weakened entering the stretch, was jostled between horses inside the quarter pole and retreated. KUTHERLOOSE trailed.
