**Footnotes**

SASSY KITTEN was allowed to settle, moved up four wide through the turn, shifted out further in the stretch, finished with a rush and was up in the final yards. ROSEE IS COZEE settled in hand, launched a bold bid four wide, opened clear with a furlong to run, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. CATBIRD SEAT was allowed settle, rallied between horses and was along for the show. FLAK tracked the pace three wide, gained a narrow lead entering the stretch but weakened during the drive and gave way. MORE THAN A SONG lunged at the start, was unhurried into stride, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. DOCTOR VICKIE LYNN contended between horses, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. PENTATHLON prompted the pace along the inside to the stretch and dropped out. WENDY AND HER CATS set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed leaving the turn and dropped out. SALT RIVER broke slow and was never a factor. ROSELAWN showed little.
