Footnotes

POKER PLAYER was unhurried into stride, got through entering the stretch, angled out inside the quarter pole, finished full of run once uncovered despite lugging in through the drive. MYGALSAL stalked the pace, launched a bold bid four wide between horses, shook clear with a furlong to run, continued on well but was unable to resist the winner. HOOCHIE POOCHIE was allowed to settle, tipped out four wide entering the stretch, lugged in through the drive but was making up ground. VICTORY COLORS prompted the pace along the inside. but weakened during the drive and gave way. HIGH RANSOM settled saving ground, moved up to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. KEENELAND KITTEN settled in the second flight and failed to threaten. BROADWAY MISSILE was close up four wide to the stretch and retreated. KING HUGO failed to respond. APACHE PARK showed little. BOSS MAN MIKE set the pressured pace between horses to the stretch, but gave way readily once headed. TEN AND FOUR was always outrun.
