TEMERAINE tucked in to save ground, took closer order through the second turn, slipped through entering the stretch and proved narrowly best in rail skimming fashion. OLYMPIC THUNDER (BRZ) was close up off of the inside, struck the front entering the stretch, fought on determinedly but was unable to resist the winner. SUNTRACER settled in hand, advanced between horses, tipped out four wide entering the stretch, loomed large but was out kicked. POTOMAC RIVER was unhurried, moved up through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and was making up ground. AMEN KITTEN was allowed to settle, made a middle move four wide, but faltered during the drive and faded. SIDE ROAD was forwardly placed four wide, but weakened between horses and retreated. WHATTHECATDRUGIN opened clear to set the pace, was headed entering the stretch and gave way.
