GERTIE, well placed, came up empty in the final furlong. PRINCESS OLIVIA pressed the pace to the stretch and weakened in the drive. AISLE SEEYA, well placed into the final furlong, flattened out. FORYOUREYESONLY failed to menace. MY MAY WEST was done early. SNOWY EGRET was outrun.
