**Footnotes**

SHADY VALLEY, well in hand while tracking the leaders for a mile, moved to the front soon after, drew off into the upper stretch and prevailed under hand urging. CIVILIAN, within easy striking distance, came out six wide entering the stretch and finished willingly as second best. WIND IN YOUR FACE, never far back, reached closest attendance to the winner at the furlong grounds but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. FOXBOAT, nicely placed from early on, raced near the inside, moved menacingly from the rail approaching the stretch, angled out four wide and flattened out late. THRYM, outrun until the final quarter, improved position slightly but wasn't a threat. CLASSIC TROUBLE went up early to press the pace four wide, took over before going a half, made the pace until the final turn and weakened thereafter. CAPTAIN WHEAT failed to rally. HONOUR HONESTY was outrun. WES SIDE STORY gained the lead near the inside early, surrendered the advantage to CLASSIC TROUBLE before going a half, remained prominent for a mile and tired. KING OF THE WORLD was outrun. STEALING HEAVEN faded after a mile. Missing fractional times were unavailable. All races at Kentucky Downs are hand timed.
