FOR THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. FREE NOMINATION. Closes Saturday, September 6, 2008. Supplementary Nominations may be made at time of entry on Thursday, September 11, 2008 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$500 to enter and start. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 at a mile or over on the turf since May 15, allowed 2 lbs.; \$25,000 at a mile or over on the turf in 2008 allowed, 4 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start by condition eligibility. In addition, no same owner entry may start to the exclusion of a single entry. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Saturday, September 6, 2008 with 38 nominations.

DEMARCATON settled in hand three wide, came four wide to make her bid, and was all out to wear down the leaders in the final strides. ST. JOE stalked the pace three wide, launched her bid entering the stretch, poked her head in front with a furlong to run, battled gamely but was turned away in the final yards. DESERT WHEAT was unhurried into stride, responded when put to pressure near the five-sixteenths marker, split horses and was gaining with every stride. FAITH'S MAGIC was allowed to settle into stride, advanced along the inside through the turn, angled out three wide to continue the rally, but grudgingly gave way from between horses in the drive. VOY POR UNO MAS pulled to the fore to set the pace, was collared nearing the furlong marker and weakened slightly in the drive. DIAMOND LURE was allowed to settle in the second flight four wide and failed to respond. DEVIL'S ATTITUDE saved ground to no avail.
