KIRI'S PRINCESS gained the lead at the start, raced four or five wide, was headed from the inside between calls on the turn by TRACI GIRL, regained a clear advantage, then was hard ridden to hold sway. FIRM KISS, within striking distance while between rivals five wide, rallied from that position and was getting to the winner at the end. MACY B., in contention throughout but six wide, couldn't muster the needed late response. MUSIC MUSE, six or seven wide most of the way, improved position but wasn't a threat. TRACI GIRL moved inside on the backstretch, made a bold run on the turn to head the winner between calls but failed to sustain the needed momentum. CLASSIC AMOUR never reached contention. LEE'S PROSPECTOR broke in a tangle, rushed up inside, held on well for a half and faded. WE LIKE GREEN raced in contention near the inside to the stretch and tired. HOME TONIGHT showed nothing and was distanced. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
