RHYTHM IN SHOES, never far back, wrested command when straightened into the stretch four wide, then drew off under mild encouragement. ARMEE ROUGE, outrun to the stretch, rallied six or seven wide and outfinished KRAKOWVIK for second while no threat to the winner. KRAKOWVIK stalked the dueling leaders into the stretch, was briefly on even terms with the winner but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. DONANDRU'S DREAM, within easy striking distance, was empty when the test came. SILKY SUMMER failed to rally. A FLEET PEACH lacked a closing account. FERVENT WISH (GB) wasn't a factor. CAPRICHA tired after racing forwardly for five furlongs. JOY OF IT ALL never reached contention. WILD BUT WORTH IT gained a slight lead early, dueled with GILDED NIP while outside that one to the stretch and tired. GILDED NIP contested the pace inside of WILD BUT WORTH IT to the stretch and tired. SHUREAMSWEET was outrun.
