Footnotes

PERRY settled under a hard hold three wide, ranged into striking distance through the turn, angled in to continue the advantage entering the stretch, forged command nearing the furlong marker and steadily edged clear. GROOM'S CAT was unhurried into stride, split horses to launch his bid entering the stretch, finished willingly and was all out to earn the place. NO QUESTIONS tracked the pace two wide, bid between horses leaving the turn, loomed a danger but lacked the needed late response. UNDER PAR broke a step slow, rushed to the lead from between horses, opened clear through the turn along the inside, but drifted out entering the stretch and gave way. RUNNINFORROB was fractious in post parade and unseated his jockey, was hustled along on the inside to attend the pace for six furlongs and faded. STRADAMUS passed only his tiring rivals. EXPLICIT LYRICS chased the pace three wide through the turn and tired. ALLEGED SOUVENIR was fractious in post parade and unseated his jockey, vied for the lead three wide for a half and stopped.
