Footnotes

KELTISH LASS settled early, rallied between horses five wide into the final furlong, then out-nodded BOBBY'S BABE on the wire in a game effort. BOBBY'S BABE, unhurried early, edged closer on the turn, made a six wide bid into the final furlong, gained even terms for the lead, then was out-nodded in the last lunge. PINE SHELTER, within easy striking distance and four wide, loomed menacingly in the late going and wasn't good enough. LUNA SOMBRA, bumped at the start by MIGHTY FRIO when that one was forced in, went up inside to contest the pace, battled forwardly into the last eighth and weakened. MIGHTY FRIO, bumped at the start by BEPPIN and forced in on LUNA SOMBRA, was never far back, made a bold run four or five wide to reach the front briefly in the upper stretch but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. LA MONEDA contested the pace along the inside for six furlongs and weakened. BEPPIN ducked in at the start bumping soundly with MIGHTY FRIO, forced that one in on LUNA SOMBRA, raced in contention to the stretch and flattened out. TIP TOP duelled for the lead to the head of the stretch three or four wide and faltered.
