COAL FIRED was slow into stride, was unhurried, circled six wide to make his move, finished full of run and was up in the final strides. TAPROOT settled in hand, moved up between horses leaving the turn, split rivals and angled out entering the stretch, finished well but was unable to resist the winner. FORT DEFIANC was allowed to settle, ranged up four wide to make a bold bid but wasn't quite good enough. TRUE BEE was unhurried into stride, angled in to save ground, shifted out entering the stretch, bulled between rivals and improved position. SOUTHERN ROCKET attended the pace three wide, but weakened between horses and gave way. ROMANS REWARD was allowed to settle, came four wide, was caught in tight and jostled near the furlong marker and lost his best chance. STRAY DOG was allowed to settle, came five wide, was bumped with a furlong to run and went evenly thereafter. BARRY DALE was close up toward the inside, was put in tight with a furlong to run, came up empty and retreated. RUN ARNIE RUN pulled clear to set the pace, was collared with three-sixteenths to run and gave way readily once headed.
