**Footnotes**

COZY KITTEN was allowed to settle, circled six wide to make his bid, drew even with a furlong to run and wore down the determined BERGERAC in the final yards. BERGERAC opened clear to dictate terms, was collared with a quarter to run, fought on gamely through a prolonged drive but was unable to resist the winner. KARAMA settled in hand, advanced between horses, came to level terms with a quarter to run, but weakened slightly between horses and grudgingly gave in. NOWHERE TO HIDE was unhurried into stride, swung seven wide and improved position. PARIS VEGAS moved into contention between horses, steadied slightly with five-sixteenths to run, got through but went evenly thereafter. PRACTICAL JUSTICE attended the pace four wide, but weakened between horses entering the stretch and faded. THREEFORALL was forwardly placed along the inside, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. YANKEE INJUNUITY settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. ST. JOE broke slowly and was never a factor.
