Footnotes

STORMY BABE sprinted to the front early, raced three wide and drew off in the lane under hand urging. RIGHT MIX raced forwardly near the inside most of the way and was second best. CHINCHILLA settled inside, was never far back, angled four wide into the stretch and bested the others while no threat to the top two. COOK'S SPECIAL, within striking distance into the upper stretch, held her position while unable to muster a closing response. COBBLEY'S JEWEL, outrun for a half, improved position but wasn't a threat. BEDEVIL, reluctant to load into the gate and outrun to the lane, passed tired foes. OBRIEN never menaced. RUBIANO'S REVENUE tired upon leaving the turn. WHATASHAMEMARYJANE stalked the pace four or five wide to the stretch and faltered. MYFAVORITESOLDIER was done early. BARBATINA, sluggish to start, was outrun. A FOUL CLAIM LODGED BY THE RIDER OF CHINCHILLA AGAINST RIGHT MIX FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE ON THE BACKSTRETCH WAS DISALLOWED. ALL RACED AT KENTUCKY DOWN ARE HAND TIMED.
